- Organize this list into categories (directional words, names of relatives, articles, etc.). Teaching words this way can be less overwhelming for students.
- Teach the sight words and then the definitions. Use examples to illustrate these words.
- Have the students come up with examples to define these words. If students can relate these words to their lives, it is easier for them.
